J (2) 1 Stone's Maynorth Back To Black, had a big age advantage. Cobby bitch. Has a well placed nose, large, expressive eyes. Domed skull. Correct neck. Well sprung ribs, short loin. Uses her rear very well. Holds a level topline & moves out well. BB; 2 Austin's Dragonheart Fall Breeze, very raw looking dog, as he should be. Not rear of 1. Rib coming along nicely. Good skull. Dark, expressive eyes. Lengthy neck. Super temperament. Well made front. BP.
PG (3) 1 Wallhead's Baldragon Becuz I'm Worth It to Merida, won on her lovely head. Correct skull, super eye & expression. Cushioned under eyes, low set ears. Has a lengthy neck. Deep chest with short loin. Can still spring in rib. Slightly untidy out & back but nice in profile, holding topline; 2 Austin's Dragonheart Of Winter, very happy boy & fairly sound mover. Rather proud of his tail on the move. Masculine head, lovely eyes, well placed nose, not domed skull of 1. Moderate angulation. Slightly long in loin, holds a level topline; 3 Austin's Baldragon Grace And Favor.

L (4,1a) 1 Austin's Baldragon May Bea Baby, delightful temperament. She has a lovely head, nicely domed skull. Level topline with well carried tail. Could have a better spring of rib; 2 Austin's Oh Dandy Boy Hero, masculine dog, front & topline earn this place. Could have more rise of skull. Enough neck. Well boned. Deep chest, well ribbed back; 3 Sellen's Levicos Ladette To Lady.

**O** (4) 1 Wallhead's Sleepyhollow Trikki Dikki at Merida, well presented masculine dog with best head in class. Nice rise in skull. Lovely eye & expression. Cobby body, moves round with style. Holds a level topline. BOB; 2 Austin's Baldragon Big It Up, liked his head & quite a good mover. Just a fraction long, holds a level topline. Enough neck. Well sprung ribs; 3 Sellen's Vashdown Diminuendo mit Sombur.
