Junior Dog 8/1

1st Mrs J Coupland, Tucherish High Treason

Seriously considered this boy for the Res CC, lovely size and shape, dead level top line, lovely head, everything where it should be, very elegant on the move, showing off his neck and shoulders. Moved really well behind, would just prefer richer tan markings, but a real classy boy.

2nd Miss J Matches, Baldragon Striding Edge to Fochai

Well marked Blenheim boy, short back, level top line, good bone, needs more body, but has lots of time, another good head with lovely rise and width, unlucky to meet the first.

Post Graduate Dog 8/1

1st Mrs M Constable, Mitapit Black Satin

Black and tan, Beautiful head, well cushioned muzzle, dark eye and nose, the true Charlie shape with good rib and bone, level top line, when settled he moved well, but a little more confidence is needed to show himself off to his true advantage.

2nd Mrs P Clarke, Stonepit Brave Bertie at Poltomic

Tri of good make and shape, level topline, moved well both ways, not the rise of dome of one, but nice boy

Limit 11/1

1st Mrs S Singleton, Silverholme Byron Celxo

Beautifully presented black and tan, in gleaming coat and condition, lovely head with nice finish to muzzle, rich tan and dark eyes, good make and shape with a level top line. Moved well in his class but pulling on the lead in the challenge let him down.

1st Ms C Robinsons, Baldragon She Demands JW,

Tri girl who I am sure will go far, pushed very hard for the CC, just needs a bit more time, she is a lovely size and shape, with level top line and good tail set, well sprung ribs and good bone. She has a lovely head, framed by long well set ears. Good reach of neck going into well laid shoulders. Very elegant on the move, moving with drive and purpose. I am sure she has a very bright future Res CC.

2nd Mrs L Gillhespy, Lorphil Lady Godiva

Similar type to one and a lot of the same applies, but she needs more spring of rib, which will come in time, a very nice girl.

Post Graduate Bitch 6/0

1st Mr R G & Mrs K M Stewart, Marchog Mimi Bon Bon

Pretty black and tan, loved her size and shape, lovely head, rich tan, moved well, short back and level top line. Sweet expression but needs more confidence.

Blenheim bitch, loved her body and bone, moved very well both ways, pushed hard for first, just preferred the rise over the eyes of one. Well handled.

Limit Bitch 5/1

This was a very pleasing girl for me as she was lovely to go over, a lot of what I said about the first applies, just felt she was not as good in head as one. Her condition and presentation is a credit to her owners, a very nice girl.
