PD 1 Fry & Jackson's Amantra Treasury, 9 months blen baby, correct size for age, excellent colour & open markings with spot. Promising baby with good mouth & bite. BP; 2 Schemel's Tudorhurst Commodore, heavily marked handsome tri, masculine at 11 months, liked his head & expression, needs to firm in movement; 3 Johnson's Tomodachi of Alambria.

JD 1 Eddleston's Palandro Theodore, tri of excellent breed type, only young & could put more into his showing. Well coloured & open markings, silky coat, lovely head & expression; 2 Schemel's Tudorhurst Firestone, blen of different type, a little rangy but sound on the move. Lovely deep colour & a very happy nature.

PGD1 Clarke's Stonepit Brave Bertie at Poltomic, very nice tri, well broken markings & silky coat, firm body, nice size, excellent tail carriage, head & expression. RCC; 2 Pennington's Tudorhurst Corsair, b/t, firm body, lovely clean silky coat, happy temperament, free in movement. Liked his head & expression. Carries his tail a little high which spoils his outline a little on the move; 3 Mochrie's Downsbank Montmomery.

LD 1 Wallhead's Sleepyhollow Trikki Dikki at Merida, tri, handsome dog I liked considerably but he must gain more confidence. Moved soundly. Well broken markings, good head & expression; 2 Mallows & Gillhespy's Binglui Berlington Bertie, ruby, 4 years, well presented & handled, good colour, sound mover, a toy dog in size yet masculine with it; 3 Dawson & Jones' Polelo Triple Chance.

OD 1 Moffat & Robins' Ch Maibee Theo, tri with a lovely clear silky coat, moves with style & holds a pleasing outline at all times. Excellent character, never stops showing, very good head & expression, lovely topline, tail high enough. Stylish mover. Good to see him take G3. CC & BOB; 2 Fry & Jackson's Ch Amantra Cheers, lovely head & eye, liked his body shape, but at times he was panting which spoiled the expression. Heavy markings, a true Charlie liked his size; 3 Pennington's Ch Tudorhurst Diamond.

PB 1 Pennington's Tudorhurst Pearl, blen, lots to like about her, good front, well broken markings, level back, nice tail, silky coat, very good condition & deep colour; 2 Pennington's Helly Dolly De La Montagne Ensoleillee of Tudorhurst, very close again on type, just preferred the body & front of the winner, lovely temperament, tail carriage correct; 3 Stone's Maynorth Back To Black.

JB 1 Eddleston's Palandro Thea, tri, still fresh & babyish. Liked her a great deal with her silky coat & well broken markings, this colour has improved; 2 Coupland's Tucherish Julie Christie, similar in type but a little skittish, preferred the coat, markings & head of winner.

PGB 1 Stone's Maynorth Love Song, tri with a nice head & expression, sound in movement & pleasing outline. Lovely silky coat. Handled well; 2 Williams' Kasamanda Miss Sunshine, pretty blen with well broken markings, spot just right, liked her size, topline & tail carriage; 3 Wallhead's Baldragon Becuz I'm Worth It to Merida.

LB 1 Robinson's Baldragon She Demands, mature tri, pretty with a lovely silky coat, well broken markings, feminine in head & good expression, extrovert which showed in her movement. RCC; 2 K Miss Sunshine; 3 Cox's Headra's Chocolate Brownie at Churchchis.

OB 1 Gurtner's Lux Ch Fleur De Lys de Melcourt, heavily marked tri, very extrovert & free moving, lovely head & expression, pleasing outline which she keeps standing & moving. CC; 2 Goodwin's Ch Maibee Clementine of Lanola, lightly marked tri, pleasing in head, a little tucked-up on the move, silky coat; 3 Mochrie & Kirschbaum's Downsbank Valentina.
