1. Salguero's CHACOMBE LORCAN. Well bodied Ruby of 7 yrs. Well domed head with low set ear, & dark round eyes. well boned, well coated, went well but could have a little more animation.

<u>Minor Puppy Dog (9, 1abs)</u> <u>A nice class of babies.</u>

- 1. Moffatt & Robin's MAIBEE HORATIO (NAF).Pretty headed tri with bright tans & dark round eyes. Good pigment, nice bone for his size, moved well around the ring holding his topline, nice neck, happy temperament. I would prefer a little more length of leg.
- 2. Sproul & Coburn's KHANDRO NO REGRETS. Another tri boy, lovely head with full dome and low set ear. Bright tans, good pigment. More masculine than 1, went well holding a good topline, but I would prefer more bone and his front needs to tighten.
- **3. Smith's JUSTACHARMA BY MAGIC.**

Puppy Dog (8,1).

- 1. Champion's STONEPIT BUSTER KEETON. Tri dog that won this class on his carriage around the ring, he went very smartly with a firm level topline & good head carriage. Full head with bright tans, nice dome, round dark eyes. He can occasionally fly his tail a little & he needs to learn how to stand unaided!! Best Dog Puppy.
- 2. Crossley's TAMELINE COMMANDER IN CHIEF. Blenheim dog in nice coat of good length for his age. Round head with low set ear. Nice large nose pad. Well boned, went soundly on the move holding his topline & good head carriage. Another that needs to learn to stand.

Junior Dog (6,1).

- 1. Johnson's TOMODACHI OF ALAMBRA. B/T that won on his head, nice & full with a low set ear, round dark eye & nice nose pad. Bright tans, well carried head, level topline & well boned. Went well around the ring. To be critical I would like a bit more width to chest & more spring of rib.

Graduate Dog. (6,0).

 Coupland's TUCHERISH HIGH TREASON. Tri dog that went well around the ring with good head carriage. Short level back, well held topline.
Long ear leathers, round dark eye. Well boned, well domed head with low set ear, I would like a little more upturn & his tan could be brighter.

- 2. Hunter's HOOEBARTON IDRIS. Richly marked blen that was not cooperating on the table, but he got it together on the move. Well domed head, round eye, well cushioned muzzle. Crested neck, short level back. Went well behind, but a bit untidy in front.
- 3. Morris' KERIZMA KOMMANDER.

Post Graduate Dog. (6,0).

- 1. Smiths HEADRA'S TRULY MAGIC IS JUSTACHARMA. Very mature tricolour with fabulous bone. Well-constructed front with good width & heart room. Cobby well ribbed body. Moved soundly both ways with a well carried head & firm level topline. Well domed head with round dark eyes & kind expression. Bright tans, well filled muzzle, nice nose pad. Coat a little unruly but he is a real dog, nothing bitchy about him, pleased to award him his first CC.
- 2. Mochrie's DOWNSBANK MONTGOMERY. Blen dog with lovely head, full dome, low set ear, well cushioned muzzle. Nice round eye, well boned with excellent front. Level topline, well carried head with crested neck, just a little longer cast that 1 & lacked a little animation.
- 3. Clarke's STONEPIT BRAVE BERTIE AT POLTOMIC.

Limit Dog (10,0).

1. Mochrie's DOWNSBANK GUTHRIE JW. Tri dog, very cobby, well boned with good front, neck & shoulders. Very full well domed head, bright tans, round eyes (which I would prefer a little darker). Coat coming in, moved Ok around the ring.

- 2. Mallows & Gillhespy's BINGLUI BERLINGTON BERTIE. Ruby boy with well domed head, low set ear & nice round dark eyes giving soft expression. Moved well both ways holding a firm topline, I would just like a better finish of face, but a nice boy.
- **3. Bailey's ALDORICKA THE MAVERICK.**

Open Dog. (7,0).

- 1. Moffatt & Robins CH MAIBEE THEO. Flashy tri dog, presented in clean condition. Well domed head, black nose pad, bright tans & round eye. Held a level topline standing & moving around the ring. I would prefer a touch more neck & tail carried a little high on occasion. Quality boy, Reserve CC.
- 2. Byers PAULIAN ERNEST WITH SIMANNIE. Blenheim with pleasing head, round dark eye giving good expression, good finish of face, good pigment. Well presented in clean silky coat, well boned, moved soundly, a little longer cast than 1.
- 3. Kendall, Askins & Vallila CH FIN INF NORD CH HEADRAS CHOCOLATE D LITE.

Minor Puppy Bitch. (11,0).

What a lovely class of puppies, very promising for the future.

1. Willey & Siddle's PENEMMA MISTY FOR ME. Very nice Blenheim bitch pup, lovely head, well domed with low set ear. Round dark eyes with lovely expression. Excellent pigment. Good coat coming for age, well presented in clean condition. Moved soundly holding her topline, nice front & bone, a touch long cast, but a puppy full of quality. Pleased to award her the RCC & BP.

- 2. William's TOVARICH LADY FAIR FOR KASAMANDA. Tri bitch placed second in a strong class on her movement around the ring. Well bodied with good spring of rib, sound moving, happy temperament. Pleasing head for age, just needs to fill in muzzle.
- 3. Lloyd's CWMHAF TE KANAWA.

Puppy Bitch (7,0).

- Stone's MAYNORTH BACK TO BLACK. Very mature B/T that could do with losing a couple of pounds. Lovely bone & spring of rib. Level topline held moving & standing. Pleasing head with round eye, good pigment, moved soundly around the ring, needs not to grow on anymore & I would like a brighter tan.
- 1. Champion's STONEPIT LILIAN GIST. Tricolour that moved smartly around the ring. Nice full head, bright tans, dark eyes & happy temperament. Went well with a good head carriage, a different type to 1 & she needs a bit more weight !!

Junior Bitch (4,0).

1. Kendall Askins& Vallila SANDSTRAND MERITUULI AT HEADRA. Very exuberant tricolour. Short level back, pleasing well domed head with bright tans & lovely round dark eye. Went well behind with a happy temperament, but a little untidy in front.

- 2. Blewett & Smith's OTHMESE LADY CHATTERLEY. Tri bitch with beautiful dome, lovely eye, low set ear. Went well holding a firm topline, nice straight front, but could do with a little more animation. Nice girl.

Graduate Bitch (3,1).

Two nice girls.

- 1. Dix's BEEWYE PENELOPE PITSTOP. Won on her better front construction & movement. Went well around ring holding her topline. Nice head with low set ears & long leathers. Very exuberant, enjoying her day out.

Post Graduate Bitch (11,0).

- 1. Johnson's HEADRA'S DELPHINE AT ALAMBRA. Heavier marked tri with lovely neck & shoulders, moved soundly both ways. Level topline, well carried head, happy temperament. Good head with round eye & bright tans. Coat needs a little work.
- 2. Hardiman's OTHMESE TIFANY TOVARICH. Ruby bitch of lovely type, well domed head, low set ear, lovely round eye. Moved soundly & happily both ways with a happy temperament. Just a little longer cast than 1.

- 1. Stone's MAYNORTH LOVESONG. Tri bitch won the class on her overall balance. Lightly marked head, pleasing type with dark eyes & good pigment. Well-constructed front, good bone, went well around the ring & sound coming & going.
- 2. Mochrie's DOWNSBANK EVENSONG. Tri with nice head & eye, low set ear, bright tans. Went soundly both ways, cobby well ribbed body, but I would prefer a little more leg.

- 1. Goodwin's CH MAIBEE CLEMENTINE OF LANOLA SH.CM. Tricolour with fabulous head, low set ear, nice nose pad & bright tans. Well boned for size, cobby well ribbed body. Well-constructed front with good neck & shoulders. Moved soundly both ways & around the ring. Showed well, pleased to award her CC & BOB.
- 2. Robinson's CH BALDRAGON SHE DEMANDS JW. Another lovely tri, possibly a little more balance than 1. Lovely head & eye, nice neck, went soundly both ways, a nice bitch, but I wish she would stand on her own !!
