- VD/B(5) 1 Pearce's Tewhit Tornado, Tri colour dog, 8 yrs old with a classic head, soft expression, dark eyes shown in good coat and condition, moved and showed well. 2 Sellen's Cofton Armino at Gmacrystals, Blenheim boy 9 yrs old, good head and pigment, compact body and presented in good coat. 3 Austin's Baldragon Big It Up.
- MPD (2) 1 Sproul & Coburn's Khandro No Regrets, Lightly marked Tri colour, with good head and dark eyes, level topline, moved well. Just needs time to body up. 2 Austin's Dragonheart Fall Breeze, Tri colour, heavier marked than one with a pleasing head, dark eyes, very happy and moved freely.
- PD(3) 1 Moffatt & Robins Maibee Horatio, Tri colour puppy, well domed head with a good finish of face and dark eyes. Correct shape and size, short in back with a level topline. Moved well, presented and shown in lovely condition. RDCC. 2 Schilizzzi & Healy-Gates Chacombe Retained Asset, another lovely Tri colour puppy, beautiful head, good bone, level topline. Needs time to body up, moved and presented well. 3 Madison's Penemma Raphael. JD (7, 2a) 1 Champion's Stonepit Buster Keaton at Lankcombe, Tri colour dog, good dome with bright tan markings. Well bodied, level topline, and moved well around the ring. Would like to see him improve on his standing, however an easy winner of this class. 2 Hall & Heslops Annkaran Jack the Lad, B/T dog with pleasing head and dark eyes. Good tan, presented in good coat and condition, moved well. 3 House's Stonepit Bradley at Triciaville.
- YD (3) 1 Champion's Stonepit Buster Keaton at Lankcombe, 2 Pearce's Kerizma Kestrel, B/T with good head and dark eyes. Compact, well bodied with level topline, moved well. 3 Dawson & Jones Caspin's Calico for Pomelo. PGB (9,1a) 1 Constable's Mitapip Black Satin, B/T with a beautiful head and well cushioned muzzle, dark eyes, but would have preferred a brighter tan. Lovely shape, level topline, moved well, just needs a little more confidence to make the most of himself. 2 Matches Baldragon Striding Edge to Fochai, Blenheim dog, masculine head, dark eyes and pigent. Short cobby body, level topline, in good coat with deep chestnut markings. Moved and showed well. 3 Moss's Vashdown Top of the Scale with Sombur. LD (5, 2a) 1 Baker & Hoenderken's Cofton A Team Daydream, Tri colour, good domed head with well cushioned muzzle, dark eyes, compact cobby body with level topline, presented in good coat and condition. Would like to have seen him enjoy his day more.. 2 Mallows & Gillhespy's Binglui Berlington Bertie, Ruby boy with large head, good dome, dark eyes and well cushioned muzzle. Deep rich colour, presented in excellent condition, moved well. 3 Wallhead's Sleepyhollow Trikki Dikki.
- OD (3) Moffatt & Robbins Ch. Maibee Theo, This is our well known Breed record holder, who I have not judged before. For me he is top quality. Good head with well cushioned muzzle, dark eyes, excellent pigment. Well laid

shoulders, level topline, he moved proudly around the ring. Pleased to award him CC and BoB. 2 Salgeuro's Downsbank Bilbo Biggins, Tri colour with domed head, soft expression. Well placed long ears, rich tan in good coat. Moved steadily, but would like to see enjoy himself more. 3 Sproul & Coburn's Baldragon Berkely for Khandro. GCDorB 1 Austin's Dragonheart of Winter.

- MPB (2) 1 Matches Khandro La Vie En Rose from Fochai, Tri colour with a good head, dark eyes and well bodied. 2 Sproul & Coburn's Khandro Ur Enuf, lightly marked Tri colour with pleasing head, dark eyes, not as cobby as one, needs time to gain body.
- PB (5) 1 Willey & Siddle's Penemma Misty For Me, I have admired this bitch from the ringside, and was not disappointed. Beautiful head, dark eyes, well cushioned muzzle giving a sweet soft expression. Well constructed, presented in lovely coat and condition, moved well with drive, pleased to award her BP I am sure she has a bright future. 2 Dawson, Jones & Lloyd's Cwmhaf Te Kanawa, Tri colour beautifully presented, with a lovely head and expression, dark eyes, level topline, happy temperament, moved well.3 Bakers Cofton in Red.
- JB (5) 1 Stone's Maynorth Back To Black, Mature B/T with a pleasing head, dark eyes. Good bone, cobby body, level topline, and she moved well around the ring. 2 Dawson & Jones's Celxo Crôme de le Crôme for Pomelo, Tri colour beautifully presented in lovely coat and condition. Good head, dark eyes, needs to body up, but moved very well. 3 Champion's Stonepit Lillian Gish at Lankcombe.
- YB (4) 1 Robinson's Baldragon Tantrum an Tiaras, Tri colour with a lovely head, dark eyes, soft expression, well cushioned muzzle. Good body and shape, level topline, moved and showed well. 2 Champion's Stonepit Lillian Gish at Lankcombe, Tri colour with a good head, dark eyes, bright tan. Good body, moved happily around the ring. 3 Dix's Beewye Penelope Pitstop.

Maibee Clementine of Lanola Sh.CM, Tri colour with beautiful head, low set ears, dark eyes, good expression, cobby body, moved and showed well. 2 Willey & Siddle's Penemma Sweet Dream, Blenheim with good head and expression, lightly marked, but presented in good coat. Moved soundly. 3 Mallows Binglui Ruby Junella.
