Puppy Dog

- 1. Lunt Ms H & Miss G – BEECHGLEN SUMMERTIME - Well broken blen. Strong in head without losing his soft expression, large dark eyes and black nose with wide-open nostrils, his head is carried proudly on a good reach of neck which is set into good lay of shoulders, level in topline which he held on the move. Well boned throughout with good width of chest and well sprung rib, moved and showed well. Pleased to later award him Best Puppy.**
- 2. Mochrie Mrs R - DOWNSBANK ALL THAT JAZZ - A well bodied dog, compact and cobbier in shape than the first, medium in bone, short in loin, level topline, dark eyes, wide-open nostrils, good depth to chest, moved with ease around the ring**
- 3. Singleton Mrs S C SILVERHOLM BYRON AT CELEXO**

Junior Dog

- 1. Mochrie Mrs R DOWNSBANK SPRUCE - Well marked tricolour, nice size, good depth and width to chest, large dark eyes, well domed skull, low set ears of good length, medium in bone, short in the loin, moved around the ring with drive, holding his level topline.**
- 2. House Mr & Mrs T J - STONEPIT MISTER ADORABLE AT TRICIAVILLE - Blenheim, with a well broken coat of good length, straight in front with good width to chest and well bodied. Pleasing in the head with broad white blaze; I would have just preferred a little more angulation in his rear quarters.**

Post Graduate Dog,

- 1. Waters, Mrs H & Robins Mrs J - MAIBEE THEO - A super class to judge with the first two being of similar size. The first caught my eye the moment he entered the ring as on the move he could**

not be faulted, He has real showman qualities, he is a lightly marked tricolour who is short and compact and well bodied, typical head, correctly domed with large dark well set eyes framed by low set ears of good length, black nose and wide-open nostrils set in a square muzzle. His head carried high on a gently arched neck which is set into well laid shoulders. Straight in front with elbows close to his chest and a good turn of stifle to his well constructed rear. Pleased to award him the Challenge Certificate and later Best of Breed.

2. Gillhespy Mrs L M – TUCHERISH SUNDANCE - A black & tan, short and cobby in profile, not the body of the first but has a nicely domed head with large dark eyes and well feathered low set ears carried flat to his cheeks, not too short in the muzzle which had ample depth and width, like the first he held his head proudly on the move holding his topline level. Good lay of shoulders with correct turn of stifle to the rear which allowed him to move freely with drive covering the ground with ease.

3. Mochrie Mrs R KUMBIA JAZZMASON (Imp)

Limit Dog

1. Plews Mrs B – TEWIT TRAFALGAR - A nice class this with the first three all being tricolours, I loved the head of this dog which not overdone. He has a broad white blaze parting large dark well set and expressive eyes which are well cushioned, he has good width and depth to his muzzle which moderate turn up, his nose is dark with wide-open nostrils. His head was carried high on a good reach of neck, and in profile he is straight in front with a level back with a good turn of stifle to the rear. Another who moved with drive holding his topline level.

2. Goodwin Mr J R - TUCHERISH STANLEY DIGGLE - Soundly made tricolour dog with masculine head yet maintains a soft expression, his large dark eyes are amply cushioned with low set and long feathered ears. His head is carried on a good reach of neck, and he has a level topline with a good spring of rib and good depth and width to his chest. He moved with ease around the ring.

3. Anderson, Mr D & Watt Mr I - NISYROS COOL HAND LUKE

Open Dog

1. Stewart Mr R G & Mrs K M - CH MARCHOG MACFLANNEL - He has a lovely topline and is well bodied. He was presented in full coat with all his feathering, he has a nicely domed head with a broad and deep muzzle and large black nose with wide-open nostrils and his eyes are dark and well cushioned. He has good bone throughout, with a well ribbed body and nice turn of stifle and moved true holding his topline.

Pleased to award him the Reserve Challenge Certificate

2 Maddison Miss S - TUCHERISH ANGELO – This soundly made and lightly marked blenheim dog is level in topline with a good depth to chest, I would have preferred a little more body on him but he moved well from the rear and stood four square.

Puppy Bitch

1. Willey, Mr I & Siddle Miss C – PENEMMA SWEET DREAM - A 7 month old lightly marked blenheim, when settled, she stood four square displaying her level topline and straight forelegs and a good turn of stifle to the rear. Whilst immature she has a nicely domed head, with low set ears, she is dark in eye with wide-open nostrils. She has a good width to chest with ample bone and a good spring of rib and on the move she displayed enough to show promise for the future.

2. Mochrie Mrs R - DOWNSBANK JAZZ DANCER - At 9 months old this short and cobby black and tan, like the winner stood four square, she too has straight forelegs good rear angulation, not as well bodied as the first but she has plenty of time to mature. She has a pleasing head with dark round eyes and nose pigment, and her head is carried on a good reach of neck. She moved fairly confidently around the ring.

3. Gillhespy Mrs L M - LORPHIL BLACK BEAUTY

Junior Bitch

1. Johnson Mrs S - ALAMBRA RUBIES N EMERALDS - Standing alone this 13 month old ruby was shown in reasonable coat for age, not overdone in the head with dark round well set eyes, broad muzzle and well cushioned under the eyes and broad in chest but she lacking body on the day, unfortunately she would not settle either standing or on the move.

Post Graduate Bitch

1. Pearson Mrs D - HEADRAS CHOC A HOLIC – A lightly marked blenheim presenting a square outline and shown in full coat. She has a good spring of rib and is well boned with good depth and width to chest. She is feminine in the head with a well domed skull and large dark eyes which are framed by low set ears of good length. She has a gently arched neck of ample length which is set into her well laid back shoulders. Straight in front with good turn of stifle which allowed her to move around the ring with drive.

2. Gillhespy Mrs L M - TUCHERISH LUCRETIA BORGIA - Another nice bitch who is short and square in body shape. She has a pleasant head with large well placed large dark eyes and broad muzzle with good turn up giving her a lovely soft expression. She carries her head proudly on a good reach of neck and has good depth to her chest and a moderate spring of rib with good angulation to the rear. She just needs to settle on the move.

3. Bailey Mr D & Mrs D M - MAIBEE MARGOT AT ALDORICKA

Limit Bitch

1. Willey, Mr I & Siddle Miss C - MAIBEE CHARLOTTE ROSE OF PENEMMA – A lightly marked tricolour with good bone and is well bodied. Level in topline with a good spring of rib and good width and depth to chest. Well domed skull with large dark eyes, well cushioned by a muzzle of adequate width and depth. Her nose is black with wide-open nostrils and her low set ears of good length are held close to her cheeks. She has well constructed forequarters allowing her legs to be straight and her elbows tucked close to her body. Her rear quarters have well

angulated stifles and well let down hocks. She excelled on the move maintaining her parallel movement around the ring.

Pleased to award her the Reserve Challenge Certificate.

2. Anderson, Mr D & Watt Mr I - MAIBEE DOMINIQUE - Slightly leaner in the body and skull than the first however she is another lovely bitch, with well broken markings and presented in good coat and condition, She has a lovely head with large dark eyes full of expression. She has a good reach of neck which flows into well laid back shoulders. Her chest is of good width and depth and she has a well angulated rear which allowed her to move with drive.

3. Lunt Ms H & Miss G - BEECHGLEN DAISEY

Open Bitch

1. Waters, Mrs H & Robins Mrs J - CH MAIBEE LAYLA - Only two in the class but in many ways they complimented each other, being of similar shape and size. The winner however excelled in the head having a nicely domed skull and good cushioning under her eyes which were large and round. She is broad and deep in muzzle with a black nose and wide-open nostrils. Well boned with good width and depth to chest. She is well bodied with good spring of rib and level topline and was presented in full coat. I was pleased to award her the Challenge Certificate.

2. Harvey Miss – CH LANKCOMBE GABRIELLA AT RIVERMOOR JW - Like the winner she has a lovely balanced head with large dark eyes bisected by a broad blaze. She is moderately boned short coupled and a good spring of rib and holds her topline. Unfortunately she did not move as well as the winner on the day.
