PD (7) Good class headed by two lovely youngsters. 1 Waters & Robins ♦ Maibee Teddie, 10 ♦ months & just had the edge on maturity, excellent mover with good tail carriage & looked lovely going round the ring, good head & eyes, pleasing neck, shoulders, front, outline & hindquarters, well broken up markings. BP;

2 Fry & Jackson ♦s Amantra Regalist, lovely head, I very much liked his balance & compact appearance with well set front & chest, good bone & limbs, well bodied for 7 months, moved soundly;

3 Quartermain ♦s Downsbank Mr Bo Jangles with Cutel.

PGD (5) 1 Goodwin ♦s Tucherish Stanley Diggle, nice compact tri, good ears, well formed underjaw with good cushioning, nice dark eyes, firm front, good chest, nice topline, well made hindquarters;

2 Singleton ♦s Andrewde Melcourt von Celxo, big bodied tri, good strength in underjaw, ears could be better set, nice bone & limbs, well set hindquarters, moved out well using his tail;

3 East ♦s Nastane Tommy.

LD (8,1a) 1 Stewart ♦s Kasamanda Celtic Connexion to Marchog, very nice tri, pleasing head & eye, good mouth, nice neck & outline, moved well, in lovely coat & condition;

2 Anderson & Watt's Maibee Blue Bayou at Nisyros, attractive ruby, good head & nostrils, pleasing eyes, good front, could be a little stronger in hindquarters but side movement good;

3 East's Tewhite Thumbs Up.

OD (11) 1 Waters & Robins' Ch Rytonian Out Of The Blue, lovely b/t, good head & ears, nice eyes, pleasing neck, shoulders & front, very good topline, well made & moved accordingly, in good condition. CC & BOB;

2 Fry's Ch Check Mate Amantra, very good moving tri, lovely head, eyes & ears, very good firm hindquarters, nicely set front. Could be better in coat. RCC;

3 Healy's Chacombe Jackson.

PB (7,1) 1 Stanbury's Inixia Love Affair, I liked this attractive blen very much, pleasing head & expression, full of character, nice outline, moved & showed well using her tail all the time;

2 Naylor's Maenan Moon Angel, nice tri, good head, well formed muzzle, good body & rib, in good coat. Not as forward as 1 & has not yet got the showmanship but I thought her very promising;

3 Juniper's Lewiscarol Ameretto.

JB (4,1) 1 Anderson & Watt's Maibee Lola, very good moving tri, good neck, shoulders & front, nice hindquarters, good tail carriage;

2 Juniper`s Kasamanda Luck Be A Lady of Lewiscarol, promising tri who had the edge in head but not as pleasing in outline or balance, can move well when she settles, good clear colours;

3 Pascoe`s Cwmhaf Lullaby of Broadway at Cwmtirion.

PGB (8) 1 Stone`s Maynorth Irresistible, I liked her very much & she pressed for a higher award. Good head, eyes & nose, pleasing front, legs & feet, good topline, well made hindquarters, moved well;

2 Allcock`s Amantra Christiania for Sleepyhollow, good tri, nice clear colours, lovely temperament & moved well, typical head, well made hindquarters;

3 Waters & Robins` Maibee Lynette.

LB (4) 1 CC, Anderson & Watt`s Tiflin The Black Pearl at Nisyros, lovely b/t, excellent to go over, good head & ears, pleasing neck, shoulders & front, very good hindquarters, moved & showed well with good tail carriage, in good coat & condition;

2 Mochrie`s Downsbank Julietta, sweet headed tri, good body, rib & depth, not moving her best in the heat but a good typy bitch;

3 Hardiman`s Cofton Razzle Dazzle `Em over Tovarich.

OB (5) 1 Fry & Jackson`s Amantra Winterberry, compact short coupled tri, very good head, lovely temperament moving out well using her tail. Could be a little firmer in front. RCC;

2 Waters & Robins` Ch Maibee Emily, well marked blen, lovely eyes & expression, good body & rib. Not quite as shapely as 1 nor as good in hind movement; 3 Stone`s Maynorth Simply Heavenly.
