

UK TOYDOG CH SHOW 2008

I was delighted with my entry, all dogs were clean & well presented, however I was extremely concerned at the poor hind movement of some of the exhibits especially in the bitch classes.

VD (3,1) 1 Schilizzi's Chacombe Morgan, 7 years well broken blen in good coat with good feathering, excellent bone & substance, broad masculine skull with dark eye, moved well;

2 Salguero-Gayhaylo Black Night at Madrugada, b/t with good bone, handsome head & dark eye. Tended to fall away at croup, lots of coat but presentation could be improved.

MPD (7) 1 Gillhespy-Lorphil Copper Sunrise, pretty headed ruby, compact shape with good bone, rich coat colour with good black nose pigment, moved soundly & with confidence. Would like a little more neck;

2 Wilson-Lichen's Ryandan, lightly marked blen in good coat, hope that he has finished growing, clean cut dog with dark eyes & good pigment, level topline, moved soundly & easily;

3 Askins-Headra's Chocolate D Lite.

PD (2) 1 Maddison's Alambra Rich Ruby, aptly named puppy, rich colour ruby with good bone, another who must not grow any further. Well presented & good temperament;

2 Rex-Parkes' Roquencourt Romney, well broken tri with sweet expression, shapely dog with rich chestnut markings a little fine in bone but good coat for age.

JD (4) 1 Leach ♦ ♦ **Amantra Carte Blanche**, well broken blen of rich colour & good pigment, promise of good coat, he moved & showed happily always with a good outline;
2 Bills ♦ **Claytonia Christiano**, handsome masculine headed dog, well marked with lovely expression, clean cut dog well presented & good temperament. His topline is not as firm as 1;

3 Mochrie ♦ ♦ **Downsbank Rupert**.

GD (8) 1 Matches ♦ **Tucherish Florison of Fochai**, well broken tri, masculine with short back & good bone, handsome head with good expression, moved soundly. Just needs more coat;

2 Morris ♦ **Palandro Winter Robin at Raytrix**, typy dog, lovely head & expression, sound moving, well presented with good strong movement. Would like him a little shorter in back;

3 Smith ♦ ♦ **Justacharma Now He Is Magic**.

PGD (9,1) 1 Shilizzi ♦ ♦ **Rosspenn Fudge Brownie of Chacombe**, richly coloured ruby with excellent bone & substance, handsome masculine head with well cushioned muzzle & sweet expression, shapely & sound on move;

2 Stewart ♦ ♦ **Marchog MacFlannel**, ruby with shapely body, good topline & handsome head & gentle expression. Just not quite the masculinity & substance of 1;

3 Smith ♦ ♦ **Ageancourt Magic Once More is Justacharma**.

LD (9,1) 1 Coupland ♦ ♦ **Tucherish Sunrise**, b/t, ideal size & good shape, handsome masculine head & soft gentle expression, moved soundly with showy temperament. My only criticism was I felt his coat was a little woolly. **CC & BOB**;

2 Smith's Justacharma He Is Our Magic, well marked blen, excellent coat & condition, so well presented with lots of feathering in all right places, excellent size & shape, he moved very well & soundly with level topline, handsome dog;

3 Lloyd's Cwmhaf Forty Second Street. OD (3) 1 Fry's Ch Checkmate Amantra, heavily marked tri, pretty head with dark eyes & good pigment, eyecatching dog with good temperament, he never stopped showing, always had a good outline but another whose coat was not at its best. RCC;

2 Mochrie Lux Ch Rosschild Oscar at Downsbank, well marked blen, a little up to size & was not moving easily. Handsome head & soft expression, good temperament;

3 Scilizzi's Chacombe Jackson.

VB (2) 1 Plews' Ch Tewhit Tandango, well broken tri in excellent condition & coat, lively & good for her age, moved happily, typical head, good skull & lovely soft expression;

2 Stewart's Ch Marchog Marilla, very pretty headed tri, dark eye, short coupled body & level topline, never stopped showing. Just not the neck or elegance of 1.

MPB (8,1) 1 Smith's Justacharma Something Magic, lightly marked blen, pretty head & sweet expression, liked her size & shape, moved well in good coat & condition;

2 Wilson's Lichen Rhonwen, lightly marked tri, pretty head & expression, dark eyes & good pigment, good bone. Was a little overawed today but an extremely nice type;

3 Gillhespy's Lorphil Copper Sunbeam.

PB (2) 1 Pascoe's Cwmhaf Lullaby Of Broadway at Cwmtirion, blen, lightly marked, well constructed with pretty head & dark eyes, compact puppy with good spring of rib, she moved soundly;

2 Rex- Parkes's Roquencourt Racamier, well marked tri, dark eye & good pigment, good quality coat. Was not happy with her surroundings & needs more confidence, a little leggy & a little strong in jaw.

JB (8,4) 1 Mochrie's Downsbank Clarice Cliff, b/t, liked her make & shape with rich tan markings & presented in good order, pretty head, lovely dark eyes & sweet expression, compact with good spring of ribs & bone, won this class despite her handler's attempts to ruin her chances;

2 Hunter's Hoobarton Dizzy Dora, pretty tri, attractively marked & shapely body. Pigment not good & is lacking coat. Very sweet expression a nice type;

3 Stone's Maynorth Irresistible. GB (7,3) 1 Pascoe's Aint Misbehavin at Cwmtirion, very heavily marked tri, pretty head, shapely body & presented in excellent condition, dark eye, good pigment & ear length;

2 Keane & Thorn's Danas Twinkle of Daddy's Eye, well marked tri, shapely with good outline, pretty head & well filled muzzle, happy bitch in good coat & condition;

3 Johnson's Alambra Isa Bella.

PGB (13,4) 1 Goodwin's Lanola Moreneta, shapely b/t, very pretty head with large eyes, good pigment & soft gentle expression, good bone & well sprung ribs, well presented in glossy coat, rich tan, moved well;

2 Williams ♦ Kasamanda Lady Be Good, well marked tri, good coat & condition. Not as compact as 1. Pretty head, typical expression, good temperament but her movement erratic;

3 Blewett & Smith ♦s Othmese Celtic Hester.

LB (13,2) 1 East ♦s Nastane Sweet Fanny Adams, well marked feminine tri, good size & shape, lovely head & expression with large eyes & good pigment, shapely bitch with good topline, she moved soundly & happily. CC;

2 Coupland ♦s Tucherish Michaela, shapely b/t, pretty head & expression. Coat was a little dull & would like a clearer tan, lacked animation on move;

3 Anderson & Watt ♦s Tiflin The Black Pearl at Nisyros.

OB (4) 1 Fry & Jackson ♦s Amantra Winterberry, heavily marked tri, typy with good head, dark eyes, rich tan & pleasing expression, short compact body with good bone, showy bitch. RCC;

2 Blewett & Smith ♦s Othmese Due Steren, well marked pretty headed tri, exquisite head & expression, happy bitch however her rear movement let her down;

3 Lunt ♦s Beechglen Daisy.
