Puppy 5

1. Mrs R Mochrie DOWNSBANK INDIAN INK – b/t square in outline with a level topline. He has good bone for his age with nice rear angulation, good depth to his chest with a good spring of rib and well laid shoulders, nice head shape with large dark eyes, low set ears, dark nose and a definite stop. He moved true around the ring.
2. Mr R S & Mrs M Baker & Kendall HEADRA'S JIM BEAM – another good mover, giving way on age, lovely square outline, with a domed skull, nice dark eyes and good width to his black nose, good cushioning under his eyes. He has reasonable bone for his age, a level topline with a good turn of stifle. He too moved well.
3. Mr S C & Mrs G A J Smith CAVELLA COMRADE FOR JUSTACHAMA

Junior 1

1. Mrs K F & Mr E L Ryan CAVALLIBROOK BLIMEY O RILEY – slightly longer in the body, he stood well holding his topline level. He is well muscled to his rear with a good turn of stifle and well let down hocks which allowed his free driving action. He has a medium length of neck allowing him to carry his head proudly. He has well cushioned dark round eyes, a dark nose and a definite stop, His chest is wide with ample depth of brisket and his elbows are held close to his body.

Post Graduate 3

1. Mr S C & Mrs G A J Smith MITAPIP BLACK IS MAGIC FOR JUSTACHAMA – b/t, short and square in back with a level topline which he held on the move. He has a good turn of stifle and straight in the front with good width and depth to chest. He has well placed ears set low on a nice domed skull. He is well filled under his eyes, with nice width to his muzzle, his head carried on an arched neck of medium length. He moved with purposed around the ring.
2. Miss V Cox PETITPAWS BLACK KNIGHT – b/t, slightly higher on the leg, he has nice tan markings, is level in back on standing, he is slightly longer in body than 1. He is well cushioned under his large dark eyes with wide nostrils and a good length to his nose. He has nice depth to his chest and a good spring of rib. I just preferred the drive of 1.

Limit 5

1. Mrs T M Jackson LANKCOMBE KINGS SPEECH AMANTRA – tri. presenting a nice square outline, he has a level topline is medium in bone and has a well sprung ribcage. He is soundly constructed with good rear angulation which is nicely muscled. He has a nice straight front with good width and depth to his chest and a good layback of shoulder. His masculine head has a good dome with low set ears framing his nice large dark eyes, dark nose and definite stop, his muzzle is wide and square and is well turned up. He excelled in movement covering the ground with drive with reach from his front. I was pleased to award him the Dog CC & later the Best of Breed
2. Miss V Cox PETITPAWS BLACK PRINCE – a square and cobby b/t who is well constructed with medium bone. His eyes are round and dark and are set well apart. His

nose is large with open nostrils. His ears are long and well furnished and are low set. He took time to settle when standing but once on the move he moved true with drive keeping his topline level.

3. Mr A & Mrs Y Arundel & Southam CHACOMBE FIN

Open 3

1. Mrs R Mochrie DOWNSBANK JEFFERY – nice tri dog, with a broad white blaze, he has a nice width and depth to his muzzle with large dark expressive eyes which are well cushioned and a wide lower jaw, his head is framed with low set ears and is carried high on an arched neck. He has good width and depth to his chest with good layback of shoulders and his elbows are held tight to his body. He is short in the loin with good rear angulation and is medium boned throughout. He moved around the ring freely and with purpose. I was pleased to award him the Reserve Dog CC.
2. Mr S C & Mrs G A J Smith JUSTACHAMA MAGIC GOES ON – another nice tri dog with a level topline, he has a nice masculine head with well placed ears and a broad blaze, he has dark open nostrils, and has ample cushioning under his large dark eyes. He has good depth to his chest, with a good spring of rib, he is short in loin with nice rear angulation and has medium bone throughout. I just preferred the movement of the winner on the day.
3. Miss C Melville CH SAROSTA CHENIN BLANC

Special Beginners 1

1. Mrs Abbott HELMAJON RHAPSODY IN BLUE – she has nice eyes and a dark nose set in an immature but developing head. Medium in bone, she just needs time to develop and gain confidence.

Veteran 2

1. Mr T W & Mrs C A Hardiman TOVARICH TEANNA – 8 year old bitch, compact and square in shape with a level topline. She has good rear angulation and a straight front. She is short in loin with a good ribcage and is not overdone in any quarter. She has a good reach of neck and a very feminine head with lovely dark eyes. She really enjoyed her day out and moved well around the ring, (Best Veteran)

Special Beginners 2

1. Mrs Abbott HELMAJON SMYTH'S CADENZA – 9 months old with well broken markings. She is very immature in head and body and just would not settle on the table long enough for me to examine her. Unfortunately, she did not improve when asked to move. A little more time required.

Puppy 8

1. Mrs T M Jackson AMANTRA SUMMER REGINA – at 11 month old this tri bitch is very mature in her body and attitude. She is well proportioned in her body which is nice and square and cobby with good rear angulation and good front assembly with depth and width to her chest and a good spring of rib. Her balanced feminine head has a broad white blaze, a broad muzzle with a wide dark nose and large dark round eyes and low set ears.

Her head was carried proudly on an arched neck which flowed into well laid shoulders on a level topline which she held on the move. A one to watch for the future. I was pleased to award her Best Puppy & Reserve Bitch CC.

2. Miss C Melville BALDRAGON RUSSIAN FORWARD – another tri, level in topline and standing four square with a good reach of neck and good width to chest. She has a nice head with a broad muzzle, good cushioning under her eyes, she has low well placed ears and she moved well, both coming and going. She just lacking the finish of 1 which I am sure will come as she develops,
3. Mr R S & Mrs R K Baker COFTON DANCING IN THE DARK

Junior 2

1. Mr B Rix BALDRAGON FAME GAME AT RIXSBURY – two litter sisters, the first being more mature in both body and head. Presenting a balanced profile she stood four square. She has a good spring of rib, is short in loin with a good width to her chest and a good depth to her brisket. She is well angulated in the rear with a good turn of stifle and well let down hocks and is medium boned throughout. Her domed head has a broad white blaze which emphasises her large dark expressive eyes, she has dark nose pigment with wide open nostrils and good width and depth to her muzzle and has well placed ears. Not overdone in any quarter, she excelled in her movement around the ring. I was pleased to award her Best Junior & Bitch CC.
2. Miss L & Mr J Tarabad & Whitman BALDRAGON CENTRE STAGE WITH KHATIBI – another nice bitch, slightly smaller in type and body than 1, she has a level topline which she held on the move, correct rear angulation with a good turn of stifle. Her head whilst still maturing has large dark eyes, dark pigmented nose and a wide underjaw, with good turn up. She moved purposely around the ring.

Post Graduate 3

1. Mr P F Lovel COFTON DREAM A DREAM AT LOVETRAC – well constructed tricolour with nicely broken markings who moved well both coming and going. She is well cushioned under her large round dark eyes with good width to her dark nose and good length to her low set ears. She just would not settle on standing but best mover in the class
2. Mrs S Stanbury COFTON TO THE MOON AND BACK TO INIXIA – showed well for her handler, standing four square when required, short and cobby in body she is medium in bone throughout. She is feminine in the head, with reasonable depth and width to her chest, she kept her elbows close to her body on the move which was true both coming and going.
3. Mrs Abbott COFTON REACH FO THE STARS

Limit 3

1. Mr J Baker COFTON FLY WITH ME TO THE MOON – a small, short and cobby bitch. Feminine in head with large dark round eyes, a nice blaze, everything in proportion. She has good depth to her chest, is short in loin with good length to her ribcage. She moved well but just needs to settle when standing.
2. Mr T N Nemeth ARROWBIEN THE SPHINX – different type of head to 1, she has very attractive body markings, is medium boned with a good depth of chest and good spring of rib ribs, she is slightly longer in the body than 1 another who moved out well.
3. Mrs C & Miss J Lewis AMANTRA TARAZED CARLEETO

Open 4

1. Miss C Gurtner Lux CH OPRAH DE MELCOURT – tri, heavier marked than 2, well bodied with good bone and a medium reach of neck which carried a nicely domed head, with large round dark eyes, which were well cushioned, wide nose, definite stop, good width and depth to muzzle, low set ears which were well feathered She has a good layback of shoulders with well sprung ribs and is short in the loin with good angulation to her rear allowing her to moved true.
2. Mr T W & Mrs C A Hardiman TOVARICH TOYAH – tri. Slightly smaller than 1, and not quite the head type as 1. She has dark eyes, a dark nose and a good reach of neck. She has good width to her chest and good depth of rib, her elbows held close to her chest she has a well angulated rear, which is nicely muscled, short in loin with a level topline, she moved well.
